DIRECTIONS

- Apply full strength to skin or surgical preparation site
- Wet area thoroughly to ensure complete coverage and penetration, but avoid “pooling”
- Allow to dry
- May be covered with bandage
- For use on companion animals, including dogs, cats, and horses
